Fly Fishing for Smallmouth & Largemouth Bass Kirk Klingensmith, Twin Tiers Five Rivers Chapter President

We welcome you to join us on December 4th at 6:30pm, when TTFR's club President, Kirk Klingensmith, will be speaking about <u>Fly Fishing for Bass</u>. Kirk has been fly fishing for 48 years, starting out with trout, later delving deeply into saltwater and bass. Kirk has become known around our region for his success in fly fishing for smallmouth – and has even guided Bob Clouser on his drift boat. Many have learned much from Kirk during the club's annual float trip on the Chemung River.

Kirk's presentation will focus on explaining bass behavior and how to adapt your fishing to more successful techniques, flies, and setups for both smallmouth and largemouth. If you are a trout specialist, but want to expand your game to these great fighting fish – this talk is for you. If you enjoy bass already, but want to amp up your game – you don't want to miss this talk.

This summer, Kirk caught and released his personal best largemouth that may have broken the PA state record. Kirk will have a photo of the beast and share a cool new fly design from the South that fooled it.

Prior to the talk, Kirk will be tying several of his favorite flies for smallmouth. If you want to catch more or bigger bass, or if you are a trout fisherman and want to branch out into other species, you won't want to miss this presentation. The fly tying segment will begin at 6:30 PM at the Big Flats Community Center, 476 Maple Street, Big Flats, NY 14814, with the main program starting directly after at approximately 7:00 PM.

Then, mark your calendar for Monday, January 8, when the Club's own resident expert on carp fishing, Jack Littleton, will be coming in to talk about carp fishing. Jack has become a very skilled fly fisher on this tremendously challenging species. Come hear the "Carp Whisperer" share his secrets in January.

Fly of the Month

CDC Caddis Dry Fly

Tied by Brent Kelley at our November Program Meeting



<u>Hook</u>: #16 dry fly

Thread: 8/0 olive

<u>Abdomen</u>: tie in a dubbed body of natural olive dubbing and wrap to the front of the hook, leaving room for wing material.

<u>**Underwing**</u>: tie in an under wing of pearlescent tan DNA fibers forward of the abdomen and clip to length between the end of hook bend and end of abdomen.

<u>CDC wing</u>: tie in two CDC feathers in succession - the first feather tied slightly in front of the underwing material and the second CDC feather over and slightly in front of the first CDC feather. Cut both CDC feathers to the same length as the underwing material. Don't cut the stems of the CDC feathers yet.

Head and legs: wrap more dubbing onto the head area and figure eight around the two CDC stems. Then clip stems to form short "legs" on each side of the head of the fly. Whip finish to complete the fly.

This is one of Brent's favorites for fishing the Genesee River and other area streams. Caddis flies are present throughout the year.
