# <u>September Program</u> Andy Cappotelli, Delaware River Guide Fishing in Montana

If you want to know more about fishing Montana, you don't want to miss our September speaker. On Monday <u>Sept 12<sup>th</sup></u> at 6:30 pm we will host local guide Andy Cappotelli who will be talking about Montana trips and tips. Andy lives in the Rochester NY area and runs a successful fly fishing guide service called Trout Snobs, which you can check out on <u>www.troutsnobs.com</u>. Andy has fished Montana many times, knows the waters of Montana very well, and will speak about his favorites, what he likes about each stream, how to do it yourself vs. taking a guided drift boat, when to go, as well as a lot more useful information. Andy operates Trout Snobs guide service, which offers guided fly fishing trips on all Western New York trout streams as well as trophy trout hunting on Lake Ontario and Lake Erie tributaries. They also specialize in guided fly fishing in the Catskills, including the West branch, East branch and mainstream of the upper Delaware as well as the Beaverkill, Esopus, Willowemoc and Neversink. Andy takes great care in tailoring his trips to meet the needs, wants, and experience levels of his customers.



# **Twin Tiers Five Rivers Chapter Library News**

With the generous donation of the estate of Dr. John Rominger, the library holdings of the Twin Tiers Five Rivers Chapter of IFFF have expanded dramatically. The more than



75 donated books cover topics that range from fly tying, fishing techniques, and fishing locations to fiction and historical reviews. As I worked with the collection, one book in particular caught my attention. The <u>Land of Little Rivers</u> by Austin McK.Francis tells the story of Catskill fly fishing in phenomenal pictures and historical and descriptive profiles of the rivers, the tackle, and the people who helped establish this region as a destination for pilgrimage of the true fly fisher. The pictures, drawings and maps are many and the written accounts are brief. Leafing through this coffee table gem will make you long for the time when you can make a trek to the Beaverkill River or the Willowemoc Creek and enjoy the beauty and bounty that the Catskill rivers provide.

I also took the opportunity to read a work of fiction in the donated collection, a flyfishing mystery titled <u>Riverwatcher</u> by Ronald Weber. The novel is set in northern Michigan on the Borchard River. It is described as a classic whodunit filled with eccentric characters. Since it is about fly-fishers there is not surprise in the description of the characters. At only a little over 200 pages, it's a fast read. It may never reach the NY Times best seller list but I enjoyed it and can give it two thumbs up. Give it a try...you'll be glad you did.
